**Measure Description:**

Creates Community Outreach and Labor Education Program within Bureau of Labor and Industries to promote awareness of employee rights.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Bureau of Labor and Industries (BOLI)

**Analysis:**

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Business and Labor to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill creates a Community Outreach and Labor Education Program (Program), within the Bureau of Labor and Industries (BOLI), to administer grants to fund outreach, education, and technical assistance pertaining to employee rights in the workplace. As amended by the -2 amendment, the bill appropriates \$2 million General Fund to BOLI in the 2017-19 biennium for the grants associated with the program. There is fiscal impact associated with this bill. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill, and the associated administrative costs, will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
