WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Expands criteria for traffic offenses related to rail crossings and adds requirement for drivers to stop for approaching on-track equipment.

REVENUE: May have revenue impact, but no statement yet issued

BACKGROUND:

Current statute only refers to "train", and the requirement to stop or yield does not contemplate on-track equipment and the need to stop or yield to on-track equipment. On track equipment may include; shoulder cleaners, defect detection cars, undercutters, spike inserter/pullers, ballast regulators, or other on-track inspection equipment.
