**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:**

Validates land use designations adopted by Metro and counties within Metro, with exceptions. Designates certain lands in Washington County as urban reserve land.

*REVENUE: May have revenue impact, but no statement yet issued*

*FISCAL: May have fiscal impact, but no statement yet issued*

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

**EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:**

-1 Removes designation of land in Clackamas County as acknowledged rural and urban reserve and rural industrial land.

**BACKGROUND:**

In 2007, the Legislative Assembly authorized Metro and metro-area counties to designate urban and rural reserves by identifying lands that might be urbanized in the future and lands that are likely to be left in a rural setting (Senate Bill 1011).

Senate Bill 186 would validate land use designations adopted by Metro and counties within Metro, with certain exceptions and would designate certain lands in Washington County as urban reserve land.
