WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Authorizes counties to use funds, directly allocated to counties and as Oregon Health Authority provided match, from Mental Health Alcoholism and Drug Services Account. Exempts sobering facilities from obligation to report specified data to Alcohol and Drug Policy Commission.

REVENUE: May have revenue impact, but no statement yet issued

FISCAL: May have fiscal impact, but no statement yet issued

BACKGROUND:

In 2015, the Legislative Assembly adopted legislation requiring the Oregon Health Authority to maintain a registry of sobering facilities. This legislation provided varying levels of immunity to sobering facilities, based on the date of registration.
