Measure Description:

Requires Department of Education and Higher Education Coordinating Commission to establish career and technical education pathways to permit students to easily progress from secondary school to public post-secondary institutions of education.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Education, Higher Education Coordinating Commission, School Districts

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Education to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill directs the Department of Education (ODE) and the Higher Education Coordinating Commission (HECC) to establish career and technical education pathways by rule that permit students to easily progress from secondary school to public post-secondary institutions of education. ODE and HECC must make a presentation during the 2018 regular session of the Legislative Assembly regarding the rules, and any other legislation that ODE and HECC believe is necessary in order to implement the provisions of this bill. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
