At the public hearing on HB 2750, Michael McElwee, the Port of Hood River's Executive Director, testified that the language in HB 2750 is built on present ODOT authority found in ORS 383. The Port has confirmed that their expectation is that rules to be adopted to evaluate any public private partnership proposal would be equivalent to the present ODOT rules and involve a very rigorous review.
