Position Statement on Grass Seed Products that are Genetically Modified or Engineered

The following statement has been approved by the membership of the Oregon Seed Association (OSA).

1. Currently, no OSA member is producing, processing, or causing to be produced or processed a grass seed product that could be identified as a Genetically Modified Organism (GMO) or Genetically Engineered Organism (GEO) in Oregon.
2. Members must advise OSA of intentions to produce or process a grass seed product identified as a GMO or GEO in Oregon six months prior to planting.
3. These intentions must be accompanied by a Stewardship Protocol that is reviewed by a Stewardship sub-committee appointed by the OSA President.
4. This statement will be updated annually or upon an announcement to OSA of a product that is a GMO or GEO.
