Measure Description:

Establishes Oregon Opportunity Commission.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Chief Education Office, Department of Education, Department of Human Services (DHS), Office of the Governor, Oregon Health Authority (OHA), Business Development Department (Business Oregon)

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Human Services and Housing to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill establishes the Oregon Opportunity Commission for the purpose of awarding funds, developing assessment tools, reviewing laws and rules, and identifying incentives to address concentrated poverty. The Oregon Opportunity Fund is established and the bill has a blank General Fund appropriation for the 2017-19 biennium. There is a fiscal impact associated with this bill; the amount of this impact is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
