Please do not allow this Senate Bill to move forward.

Concerning SB 868

If the COURTS actually feel that a person **presents imminent risk**, or risk in foreseeable future,

of suicide or causing injury to themselves or others, the State should keep the other citizens of

the State safer by requiring mental health testing, review and treatment for those people.

Removing items such as firearms, cars, knives, ropes, hammers, screwdrivers etc., probably only delays such actions. It's the mental health of the individual that is the basis of what the State is truly being asked to determine with this issue.
