HB 3006 -1 STAFF MEASURE SUMMARY

WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Requires Oregon Department of Forestry to establish list of Oregon-based contract firefighting companies and dispatch resources of those contract companies prior to obtaining resources from federal agencies.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Local and state response to wildfire events
- Preference for Oregon contractors
- Issues of proximity and cost

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

-1 Replaces measure. Requires Oregon Department of Forestry to establish list of Oregon-based contractors determined to be qualified to supply department with wildfire suppression support. Requires department to create matrix of processes department uses for dispatching wildfire fighting resources and to post this matrix on publicly accessible website. Requires department to establish initial list of Oregon-qualified contractors prior to fire season beginning January 1, 2018.

BACKGROUND:

The Oregon Department of Forestry (ODF) is currently tasked with the management of wildfires throughout the State of Oregon. During 2016, ODF managed 831 fires encompassing over 50,000 acres. ODF was able to complete this task through the contracting of 46 private wildfire fighting companies.

House Bill 3006 would require ODF to create a list of private wildfire fighting contractors, and prioritize Oregon-based companies to provide such services.
