**Measure Description:**

Modifies requirements for coordinated care organizations in 2018 and 2023.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Oregon Health Authority (OHA)

**Analysis:**

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee Health Care to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

House Bill 2122 with the -8 amendment requires all coordinated care organizations (CCO) that have contracts with the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) to be community-based nonprofit organizations. The bill details the requirements of CCO governing boards.

This bill is anticipated to have a fiscal impact to the Oregon Health Authority. The amount of this impact is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
