I STRONGLY oppose HB 2023 as I think it opens a horrible can of worms to devalue farm land. This has tentacles elsewhere and would greatly reduce private property rights. We do NOT need ANY MORE even hinting at projects on FARM LAND especially irrigated farm land or quality land that is so great it does not need irrigation.
