Measure Description:

Extends the time in which owners of Metolius resort sites may seek the approval of a small-scale recreation community.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Land Conservation and Development, Counties

Summary of Expenditure Impact:

The amount of the fiscal impact is indeterminate.

Analysis:

HB 2031-1 allows the owner of a Metolius resort site to apply to a county for approval of a small-scale recreation community. The affected county is likely to experience some fiscal impact, especially if there is an appeal of the county decision, although the amount is indeterminate. According to information provided by the Association of Oregon Counties, costs associated with such an appeal would likely be between \$25,000 and \$50,000. The Department of Land Conservation and Development does not expect to incur any costs as a result of the measure.
