WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Prohibits person's blindness serving as basis for denial or restriction of custody or parenting time, participation in adoption proceedings, opportunity to provide foster care or ability to serve as guardian. Requires opposing party in domestic relations or juvenile dependency to prove by clear and convincing evidence that blindness is likely to endanger child. Requires court to adopt specified findings when court denies or limits certain rights related to custody, parenting time, foster care, guardianship or adoption.
