RE: SB 5524, OHSU Budget

Dear Joint Ways & Means Subcommittee on Education

The Oregon Society of Physician Assistants (OSPA) recommends that you support the budget for the Oregon Health & Science University for the 2017-19 biennium.

Our organization is the professional society that represents physician assistants (PAs) in Oregon. As you may know, OHSU is a national leader in their PA program, which is consistently ranked within the top 10 PA programs in the United States. In addition, OHSU is a premier medical school training hundreds physicians, dentists, pharmacists, nurses, paramedics, and many other health care professionals every year who go on to provide medical care all across our state.

As Oregonians we can all be very proud of our medical school and the many programs it supports. As the ultimate resource for medical treatment, OHSU employs the most qualified and expert medical providers and provides the most highly specialized medical care to Oregonians. Patients from all over the state are brought to OHSU for specialized treatments that are available nowhere else.
