I would not be in favor of either SB 797 or 868.

868: This is firearm confiscation, clearly a violation of the second amendment. Allows peace officers, family members, or household member to "determine" on their own if someone is posing eminent extreme risk. Still further, it provides peace officers enhanced ability to circumvent fourth amendment search and seizure process to confiscate firearms and ammunition and CDL prior to filing of the order. Does not disclose what happens to confiscated firearms, or whether the individual is able to reinstate eligibility status, or whether they get their firearms back if they prevail during the hearing. Way too close to outright firearms confiscation and would establish a precedence.
