HB 3261-2

<u>Summary</u>

The -2 amendment directs the Oregon Health Policy Board (OHPB), in collaboration with the Office of Rural Health (ORH) to consolidate and develop uniformity for certain health care related financial incentive programs.

Comments

There are two separate bills, which if enrolled, will increase the professional fields eligible to claim certain rural medical care tax credits. House Bill 2273 seeks to add pharmacists and Senate Bill 341 seeks to a medical clerks or medical preceptor. We point this out to ensure that those changes are also accounted for in this bill as all these bills progress.
