**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:**

Authorizes Governor to enter into agreement with another state for purpose of cross-jurisdictional coordination and enforcement of marijuana-related businesses.

*May have fiscal impact, but no statement yet issued*

*Minimal revenue impact*

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

**EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:**

No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:**

Senate Bill 1042 authorizes the Governor or her designee to enter into agreement with another state for purpose of cross-jurisdictional coordination and enforcement of marijuana-related businesses. It also specifies requirements for entering into this agreement, such as that the border of the other state must abut the borders of this state. SB 1042 also specifies several modes of transportation that must be prohibited in the agreement, such as transportation of marijuana items through navigable airspace.
