# **Measure Description:**

Requires contracting agency to perform analysis to determine whether constructing public improvement with contracting agency's own equipment and personnel will result in least cost to contracting agency.

Secretary of State, Bureau of Labor and Industries, Department of Administrative Services, Statewide

### **Analysis:**

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Business and Labor to the House Committee on Rules. The bill establishes new requirements on public contracting agencies and assigns responsibilities related to investigations of complaints. It is anticipated that there is a fiscal impact associated with this bill, but the amount of this impact is still being determined.
