Measure Description:

Modifies provisions regarding schedule by which local public health authorities must submit local plans for applying foundational public health capabilities and implementing foundational public health programs.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Counties, Oregon Health Authority (OHA)

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Health Care to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. This bill modifies the provisions regarding the schedule by which local public health authorities must submit local plans for applying foundational public health capabilities and implementing foundational public health programs. This bill will have a significant fiscal impact on the Oregon Health Authority and on County Public Health Departments. OHA estimates a General Fund impact of \$49,293,122 for the 2017-2019 biennium and \$61,655,421 for the 2019-2022 biennium. The Counties estimate that implementation of this bill would cost \$43.9 million. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
