Measure Description:

Establishes Task Force on the High School Graduation and College and Career Readiness Act.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon Department of Education (ODE)

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Education to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

Senate Bill 353 with the -1 amendment removes the minimum funding requirement that the Legislature is obligated to appropriate to the High School Graduation and College and Career Readiness Grant. The bill authorizes the Oregon Department of Education (ODE) to retain up to one and one-half percent of the High School Graduation and College and Career Readiness Grant Fund for the administration of the dropout prevention and college readiness initiative.

The bill is anticipated to have a fiscal impact on ODE. The amount of this impact is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
