## **Measure Description:**

Requires State Department of Agriculture to adopt rules governing posting of tax information by gas stations.

## **Revenue Impact (in \$Millions):**

This statement is issued to facilitate the referral of this measure to the House Committee on Revenue.

## **Impact Explanation:**

Gas station owners and operators are currently required to post the amount of federal, state and local tax per gallon in a manner visible to customers. The Oregon Department of Transportation is required to furnish tax information to gas station owners and operators for this purpose.

House Bill 3338 would direct the Oregon Department of Agriculture to adopt rules for implementation and

enforcement of the posting of tax information at gas stations.

The measure will be analyzed further when it is taken up by the revenue committee.
