This bill would make our communities safer by:

- Protecting women and children by prohibiting convicted stalkers and abusive dating partners from having guns;
- Requiring state officials to alert law enforcement when an individual prohibited from purchasing a firearm attempts to do so illegally and fails a background check;
- Closing the "Charleston Loophole," which allows a gun sale to proceed after three business days, even if the background check is incomplete.

This bill will alert police officers when someone tries to buy a gun who shouldn't be in possession, helping them do their jobs.
