Measure Description:

Authorizes Psychiatric Security Review Board to establish restorative justice program.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon Health Authority (OHA), Psychiatric Security Review Board, Oregon Judicial Department,

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Judiciary to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

Senate Bill 65 with the -3 amendment modifies language relating to jurisdiction over offenders, removing the "tiers" of offense classifications, effectively dissolving the Oregon Health Authority State Hospital Review Panel and transferring the jurisdiction of all guilty except for insanity (GEI) patients at Oregon State Hospital to the Psychiatric Security Review Board.

This bill is anticipated to have a fiscal impact to the Oregon Health Authority, the Psychiatric Security Review Board, and the Oregon Judicial Department. The amount of this impact is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
