Measure Description:

Changes water management and conservation plan approval condition for extension of time to construct works or perfect right for municipal use of water.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Water Resources Department

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Agriculture and Natural Resources to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill changes conditions for water management and conservation plan approval. The -3 amendment requires permit holders to confer with the State Department of Fish and Wildlife to identify potential effects on fish from the use of the water under the permit. The bill requires water right holders to make monthly payments of \$5,000 for failing to comply. The Legislative Fiscal Office anticipates having a fiscal impact associated with this bill, the amount of this impact is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
