Chair Prozanski and members of the committee,

My name is Sal Peralta. I am a resident of McMinnville and Secretary of the Independent Party of Oregon. I am testifying in favor of SB 868, which establishes a legal process for firearms to be confiscated in the event of an extreme risk situation where a person may be a hard to themselves or others.

## Some key statistics to consider as your committee debates this legislation:

More than half of all gun-related deaths are suicides. Of the more than 44,000 suicides in 2015, 58 percent of them, 25,000, involved a firearm.<sup>1</sup>

Fewer than 10 percent of all suicides are attempted using a firearm, however more than half of all suicide completions involve a firearm because of the lethality of firearms (nearly 85 percent of suicides attempted with a firearm are successful).<sup>2</sup>

An abundance of resreach shows that most people who are denied their primary method of attempting suicide will not attempt using another method.<sup>3</sup>

Pro life legislators who believe that suicide is a mortal sin are encouraged to pray and reflect on that data.

Although this issue can generate a great deal of intense response by a loud but relatively small minority of the American public. By a ratio of 4-1, IPO members who express an opinion about gun regulation favor reasonable gun regulations along the lines of this legislation.
