Measure Description:

Establishes Indian Health Scholarship Program to provide free tuition and fees for qualifying Indian health profession students in exchange for student commitment to work at tribal service site after graduation.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Revenue(DOR), Oregon Health Sciences University (OHSU)

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Human Services and Housing to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill establishes the Indian Health Scholarship Program which is administered by the Oregon Health Sciences University (OHSU). The bill has a blank General Fund appropriation clause to OHSU in the 2017-19 biennium. There is a fiscal impact associated with this bill. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
