WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Requires owners and employees of marijuana businesses licensed by Oregon Liquor Control Commission (OLCC) report violations of marijuana laws or regulations. Requires OLCC to suspend or revoke a license if an owner or employee does not report violations of marijuana laws or regulations.

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

BACKGROUND:

Oregon state law mandates that workers in certain professions must make reports if they have reasonable cause to suspect unlawful activities relating to the abuse and neglect of children or the elderly. These people are often referred to as "mandatory reporters."

Senate Bill 874 would require OLCC licensees and their employees report any violation of marijuana laws or regulations. If they do not do so, the license they work under could be suspending or revoked.
