




APPLICANT CERTIFICATION

By submitting this application, the authorized person for the District identified in sections 14 & 15 above:

Seismic Preference Points

- 1. Small District Under 2,500 ADMr
- 2. SSF Poverty rate 25% or higher
- District has not conducted assessment for SRGP
- 4. RVS data for district buildings indicate bad construction type, structure, and built before 1995*
- 5. District in "high shaking zone" per USGS

* If District not in RVS, then given point if built before 1995


