Subject: Oregon Employment Department: HB 5007 - POP #101 - Modernization Initiative

JLCIMT Recommendations

The Joint Legislative Committee on Information Management and Technology (JLCIMT) recommends incremental, conditional approval of Policy Option Package #101 assuming the spending authority and personnel resources are made available to the Oregon Employment Department (OED) within HB 5007. Specifically, JLCIMT recommends that OED:

- 1. Continue to work closely with and regularly report project status to the Office of the State Chief Information Officer (OSCIO) and the Legislative Fiscal Office (LFO) throughout the project's lifecycle.
- 2. Follow the Joint State CIO/LFO Stage Gate Review Process.
- 3. Continue to contract for or hire qualified project manager(s) with experience in planning and managing projects of this type, scope and magnitude.
- 4. Develop and update Business Case and foundational project management documents as required.
- 5. Work with OSCIO to obtain independent quality management services. The contractor shall:
 - Conduct an initial risk assessment.
 - Perform quality control reviews on the Business Case, and foundational project management documents as appropriate.
 - Perform ongoing, independent quality management services as directed by OSCIO.
- 6. Submit Business Case, project management documents, initial risk assessment and quality control reviews to OSCIO and LFO for Stage Gate Review.
- 7. Report back to Legislature on project status during the 2018 Annual Legislative Session and/or to interim Legislative committees as required.
- 8. Request Legislative approval to proceed with the project prior to initiating project execution activities (i.e. prior to contract signature/execution).
- Utilize OSCIO's Enterprise Project and Portfolio Management system for all project review, approval, and project status and QA reporting activities throughout the life of the OED Modernization Initiative.
