Measure Description:

Allows Department of Consumer and Business Services to deny an application for registration or renewal as a pharmacy benefit manager, and to revoke or suspend registration as a pharmacy benefit manager, under certain circumstances. Removes the cap on fees the department may charge for pharmacy benefit managers to register or renew registration.
