Re: Authority of ports to operate shipyards

Dear Representative McKeown:

You asked whether, under current law, a port is authorized to own and operate a shipyard in direct competition with a local private enterprise. **The answer is probably yes, although our conclusion is not free from doubt.**

Ports are governed by, and derive their powers from, ORS chapter 777. Nothing in that chapter explicitly authorizes the ownership and operation of a shipyard. However, ORS 777.258, a catchall provision, broadly authorizes a port to, in relevant part, "do such other acts and things . . . as tend to promote the maritime shipping . . . and commercial interests of the port," even if not explicitly authorized by other law. There is no textual limitation on the scope of maritime shipping or commercial interests contemplated by this section, and we think a court would be likely to find that the operation of a shipyard advances a port's maritime and commercial interests.

The authority granted by ORS 777.258, however, is not unlimited. Courts have held that a port's authority may only be exercised to carry out "a legitimate Port activity or purpose authorized by law." *Harrison v. Port of Cascade Locks*, 27 Or. App. 377, 381 (1976) (stating in dicta that explicit statutory authorization to build cableways would not legitimize port's construction of a ski lift). After a remand and second appeal of *Harrison*, the Oregon Court of Appeals held that building and operating a recreational tramway was not a legitimate port activity and was thus outside of a port's authority, even though ports are explicitly authorized to build tramways. 37 Or. App. 391, 394-395 (1978).

Despite this limitation, we think it is likely that a court would determine that the operation of a shipyard is permissible. Although the *Harrison* court did not provide detailed guidance on the parameters of "legitimate" port activities, it noted that the "primary function" of a port is to "aid[] the movement of goods and services in commerce." *Id.* at 395. Operating a facility to service, repair and build ships can easily be argued to be in aid of the movement of goods in commerce. We also think it is relevant that Oregon ports appear to have operated shipyards for many decades. If ports have historically operated shipyards, a court would be more likely to find that shipbuilding and ship repair are legitimate port functions.

We caution, however, that there is little case law or other authority on this issue, and we cannot be certain how a court would rule.

Finally, nothing in chapter 777 explicitly or implicitly prohibits a port from competing with private enterprise. In fact, ports are explicitly authorized to engage in activities that are almost certain to compete with private enterprise, such as operating watercraft "for the transportation of all kinds of merchandise, freight and commercial or recreation passengers," constructing industrial buildings for sale or lease to private entities and operating "sports, recreation, convention and trade show facilities." ORS 777.195 (1), ORS 777.250 (1), ORS 777.250 (3).

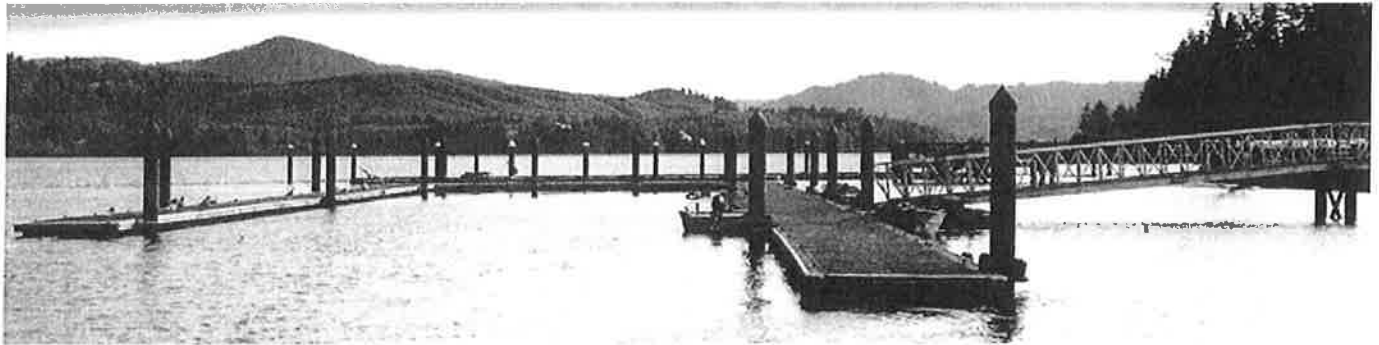

Current Projects

During the December, 2015 storms, the area surrounding the Port's boat launch area and marina received an additional 11,000 cubic yards of siltation. Also, the Port lost two of the pilings on its debris boom. The Port filed a FEMA claim on the damages. The Port had previously filed for a dredging permit with the Corps of Engineers and the Oregon Department of State Lands. The Port is part of the South Ports Coalition and is now scheduled to use the State's newly purchased dredge during the in-water work season, which begins on November 1, 2016. After the dredging is completed, repairs will be made to the debris boom.

The Port's maintenance staff is currently making repairs to the commercial dock. In addition, they are numbering the side-tie slips on the recreational docks; boaters wanting moorage will now be assigned specific sites on the docks to moor.

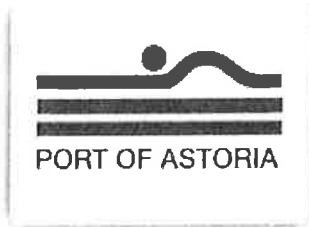

Boatyard General Information



Located at rivermile 13 at the mouth of the Columbia River, the Port of Astoria's haul-out facility and ample boatyard are ideally situated for boaters from the Columbia River basin, and also serve West Coast boater traffic. In-water, upland storage, and long-term boat storage and trailer parking are available at rates significantly below those in urban areas.

The facility includes an 88-ton TraveLift®, offering excellent lift efficiency and providing greater versatility when placing the vessel ashore for storage or repairs. A wash down system makes it easier to remove algae and barnacles from a boat bottom, and dispose of this material properly.

Haul-Out Reservations are required, and may be made by calling the Marine Service Supervisor 8am to 4:30pm at 503-791-7731.

Boat owners may contract for repair work with an on-site marine repair business, or lease boatyard space for do-it-yourself work. Amenities at the Haul-out/Boatyard include:

Double lane boat launch - \$2.00 to launch payable in the metal box next to the ramp. Launch fees apply to kayaks, canoes, paddle boards.

Access your temporary parking permit at the head of the launch ramp. Annual Launch Pass Permit is \$45 a year-Seniors (55 yr.+) \$35 available at port office.

The boat launch is affected by tides. Please read information posted on launch ramp piling in regards to tides. The boat launch and launch parking lot are provided by grants from the Oregon State Marine Board. Parking provided in the launch lot is for vehicle-boat trailer combinations only. Other parking is provided across the street, including R.V. parking. Please do not leave unattached boat trailers in our lot.

Please be courteous to all other launch ramp users. The NO PARKING area marked with diagonal yellow stripes and RED curbs on the north side are staging areas only. This allows both lanes of the ramp to be used at the same time so no one has to wait to launch. We hope you enjoy our facilities and have a great time fishing and crabbing on the Coquille River.

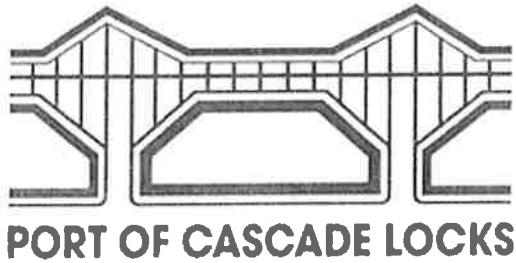

NOTICE: MARINE PARK BOAT RAMP (both sides) will be closed for repairs for up to 10 days, starting on **Monday, February 13th**. We apologize for the inconvenience.

More about this project:

The Port of Cascade Locks applied for a Boating Facility Grant through the Oregon State Marine Board (OSMB) and received \$25,000 to repair the boat ramp in Marine Park. The Port matches 25% of this at a cost \$6250. The Oregon State Marine Board will pay \$18,750 to replace and extend the ramp toe. During low water periods, boat trailers are dropping off the ramp, causing many trailers to be towed. This causes unsafe boating conditions. The Army Corp of Engineers in-water work period is between November 15 and March 15. The Port will repair the ramp the week of February 13 for 7-10 days, and during the allowed in-water work period. The entire end (ramp toe) will be replaced and extended during this time by Elk Mountain Construction out of Sandy, OR. Please contact the Port of Cascade Locks at 541-374-2400 for more information. The ramp repair project was originally scheduled for January 16, but due snow and ice storms was delayed.

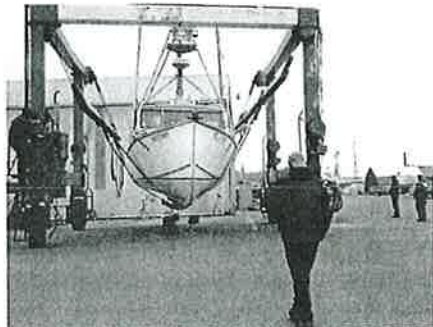

Port of Hood River Marina offers a protected harbor for boats with access to the Hood River and is a hub of local recreation and activity. As part of Port of Hood River Marina facilities include year-round and transient moorage for various-sized boats, a public boat launch, fuel dock (with water and pump-out station), and the Community Building on the east end of the Hood River waterfront recreation area.

In addition to moorage, the Marina area hosts youth sailing lessons and small boat launching for kayaks, outrigger canoes, rowing skulls, small sail craft and stand-up paddle boards. Yacht club and sport activities combine to make the Marina a family-friendly facility complete with nearby park areas, lawn, beach and playground that provide areas for play, sports, or passive enjoyment.

Access to the Boat Marina is through Port Marina Park on the north side of Interstate 5-84 at Exit 64 and State Highway 35 near the Hood River Interstate Bridge.

Port of Hood River Marina currently offers close to 160 boat slips for long-term moorage in a large facility. Slips are categorized for boats up to 30 feet in length, over 30 feet in length, and over 45 feet in length with a 66-foot maximum. A limited number of

Slips are offered on the South Basin Dock for boats under 23 feet in length. The North Dock is available for short-term moorage on a first-come basis (overnight moorage is based on length of vessel). The North Dock is reserved for small cruise ships that visit Hood River. A limited amount of dinghy storage is available through the Hood River Yacht Club.



The Hood River Marina has been designated an Oregon Marine Safety Board Clean Marina.

The Hood River Marina operates with an emphasis on safety and is certified as a "Clean Marina" by the State Marine Board. Boaters must observe local rules in addition to local and Oregon State Marine Board rules, including the No Wake Zone. Caution and slow entry and exit by boat to and from the Columbia River is recommended due to shallow water near the basin mouth. Complete Marina Rules and Regulations, along with policies on subletting, utility charges, and the Marina Wait List for each type of vessel are available.

Facility improvements continue to be a priority for the Port of Hood River. The facility has undergone significant enhancements in recent years, most notably a complete electrical system upgrade, and replacement of boathouse docks. Due to the high demand for moorage, the Port of Hood River maintains a waitlist and plans to

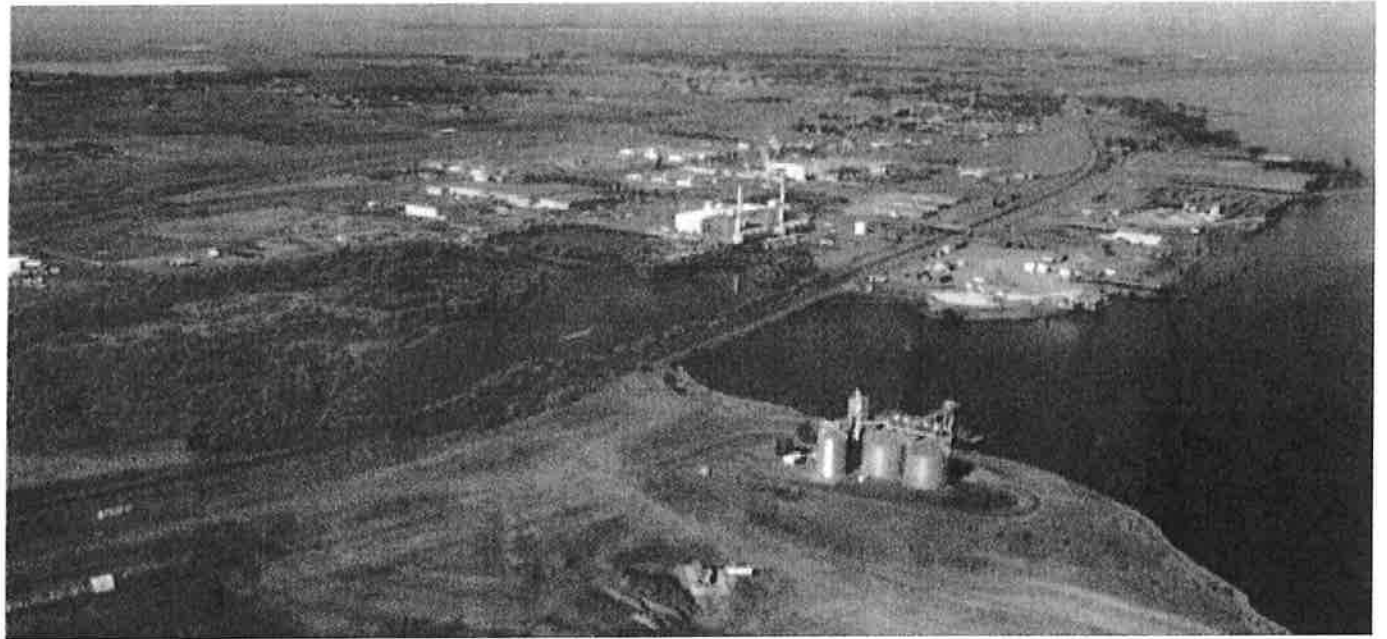

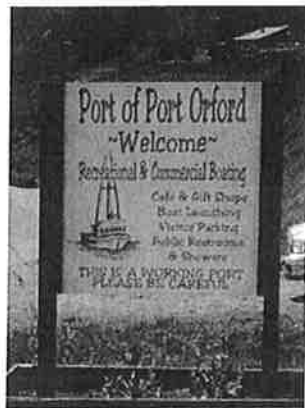

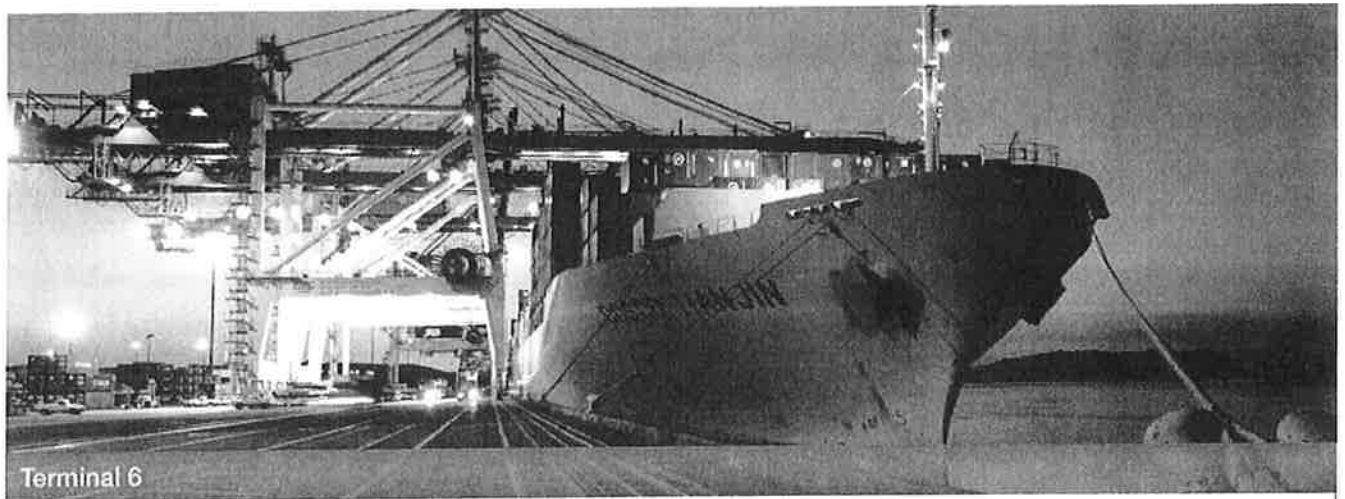

*** **News Alert***** New lifting policy - As of July 21st, 2015, the Port of Port Orford will now lift boats with OSHA approved lifting straps with current certification of inspection stamped on the straps. The OSHA approved lifting straps must meet the weight requirement for the specific vessel being lifted and the current certification date must be visible for inspection by the lift operator before being placed in the water. Remember, it is the responsibility of the boat owner to make sure all ropes, lifting straps, and attachment points are in good working order. The Port of Port Orford assumes no responsibility if your ropes, lifting straps, or attachment points fail.

Fishing – Have your own crab ring? Come down and toss it off the dock to bring up a tasty treat! Make sure to check the current regulations and have the proper licenses before you fish! Never leave your crab pots, rings unattended.

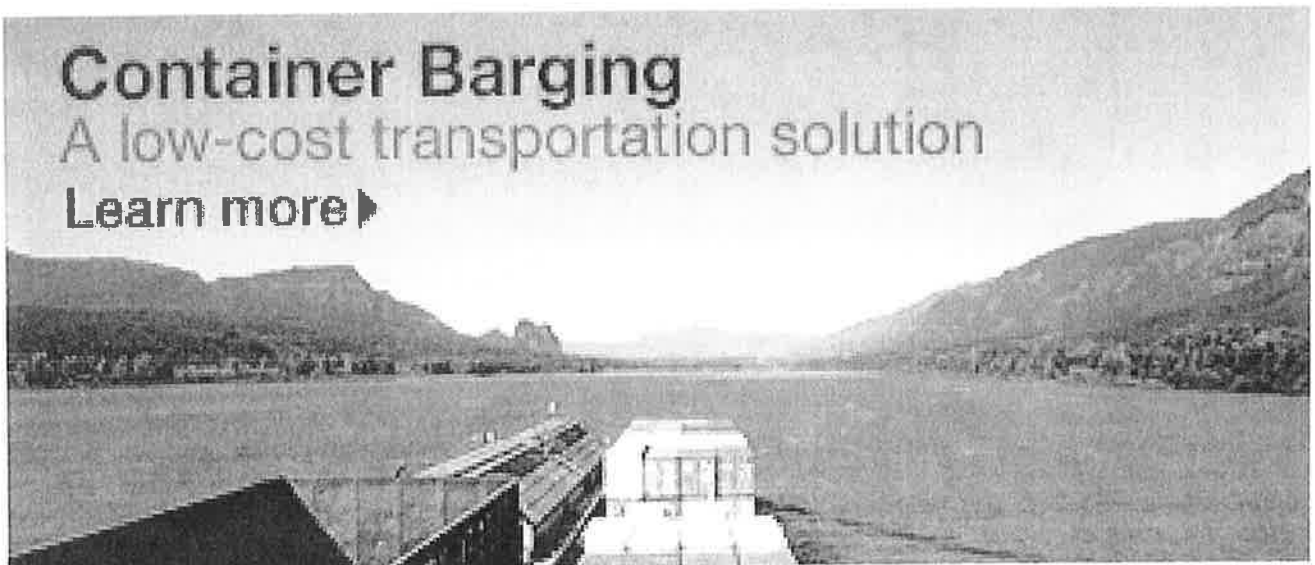

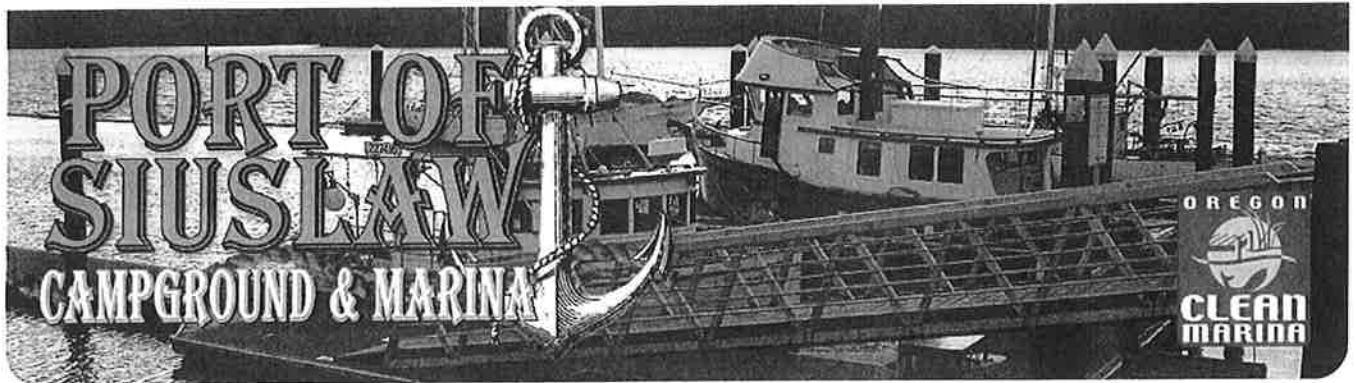

Rates apply to the following listed services provided to the public with Port of Siuslaw personnel, equipment or contractors at the Commercial Basin, Sportboat Moorage, Rental Storage Facilities, Commercial Fishing Storage Area and on all other Port properties. All hourly fees shall be charged in minimum ½ hour increments unless otherwise stated. Service charges apply from initial mobilization to final demobilization, and include travel time when required.

The Port of Siuslaw cannot guarantee the availability of equipment or personnel to perform the listed services. Port operations have priority over requests for services to the public, and services to the public will be provided only on an as available basis.

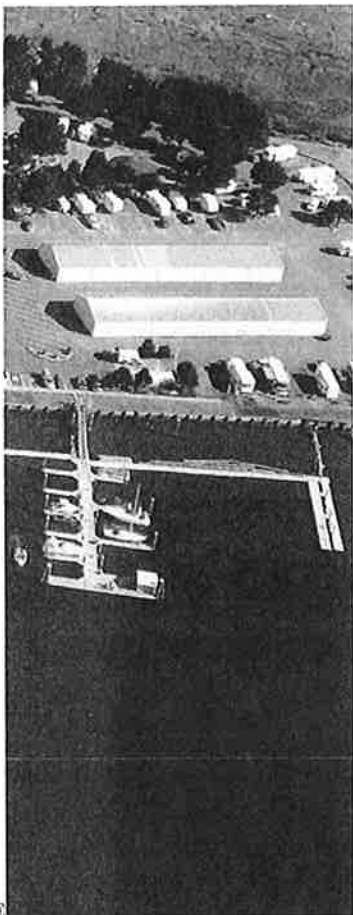

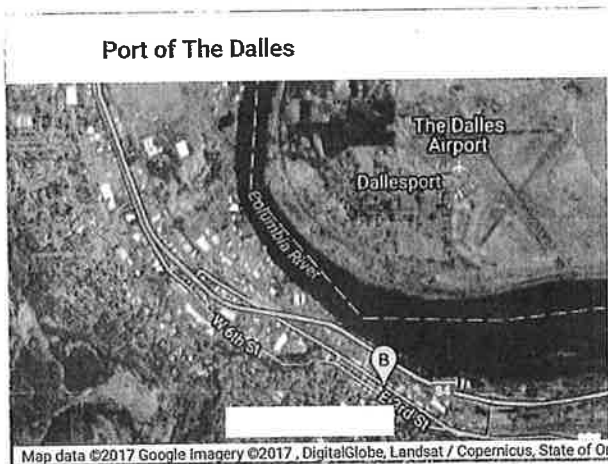

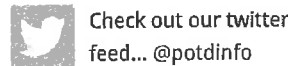
