Dear Senate Committee,

Regarding SB 868, Creates process for obtaining extreme risk protection order prohibiting person from possessing firearms when court finds that person presents imminent risk, or risk in foreseeable future, of suicide or causing injury to other persons. Establishes procedures for peace officer or family or household member of person to apply for order. Establishes procedures for respondent to request hearing, and for continuance of extreme risk protection order after hearing or if hearing is not requested. Establishes procedures for termination and renewal of order.

I am an US navy vet, and a voting Oregon resident and a proud American. I urge you to say no to Senate Bill 868. It does nothing to protect law abiding citizens that have the right to own arms under the 2<sup>nd</sup> amendment of the constitution and state constitution and law from being unfairly targeted, reported and have their firearms rights taken away. No person without due process shall have their rights removed, nor shall there be a court action that removes their rights without a jury, nor shall the accused not be able to face their accusers. A law that allows for the confiscation of an individual's property and then makes them fight to get it back is abusive, overreaching and flat out dangerous. Ultimately this law would create a legal path that would allow the confiscation of private property based off of accusations without providing any protections and this is completely unacceptable.
