East side to west side connection of Deschutes River Trail in Bend could be blocked by bill in Oregon Legislature

The Bend Park and Recreation District has been working on a longstanding community vision to connect the Deschutes River Trail (DRT) on the east side of the Deschutes River to the DRT and other Deschutes National Forest trails on the west side of the river at the south end of Bend.

The DRT trail connection would increase District residents recreation opportunities for hiking, walking, biking, fishing, river recreation, naturewatching and more.

This connection has been identified in numerous community plans for decades, and was most recently included in the District's 2012 bond measure approved by the voters.

Currently, the Oregon Legislature is considering House Bill 2027-A that would prohibit development of the bridge necessary to make this trail connection.

A hearing on this bill is scheduled for:

- 3 pm on Wednesday, May 10 in Salem before the Senate Committee on Environment and Natural Resources
