WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Expands the circumstances under which the Oregon Department of Transportation may enter into agreement with an integrator to conduct certain functions of the Department on behalf of the Department. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

FISCAL: No fiscal impact

REVENUE: No revenue impact

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

The term "integrator" refers to an entity that enters into a contract with the Oregon Department of Transportation to provide information and transact business for the Department. For example, an integrator may facilitate and complete titling and registration plate transactions for a car dealership. Under current law, integrators are limited to the electronic issuance of vehicle titles, immediate issuance of title and registration, and written and skills testing for driver licenses and permits, including commercial driver licenses.
