Measure Description:

Authorizes Department of Transportation to issue driver licenses, driver permits and identification cards that meet requirements of federal Real ID Act of 2005.

Revenue Impact (in \$Millions):

This measure is expected to be referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, thus this statement is issued to facilitate in that purpose.

Impact Explanation:

DMV costs are taken off the top of the highway fund revenues. The remainder will be distributed among the State, Cities, and Counties. If there is a fiscal cost to this measure, then the revenue will be evaluated after the budget process takes out the cost leaving net amounts of revenue.
