Measure Description:

Allows person with pending application for teaching license to teach in public school for limited time if certain requirements are met.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Teacher Standards and Practices Commission

Analysis:

The potential revenue loss to Teacher Standards a Practices Commission (TSPC) with passage of this bill is estimated at \$846,320 Other Funds per biennium.

The Legislative Fiscal Office released a “Minimal Expenditure Impact” on 3/17/2017 for SB 205-A based on an estimated potential revenue loss of less than 4% of Other Funds per biennium associated with the TSPC no longer charging a fee for expedited educator licenses. This revenue loss would be off-set by TSPC no longer needing to incur costs associated with overtime pay to process these expedited licenses. However, after further review it was determined that the historical revenues for expedited licensing fees, which were used to calculate the potential revenue loss, had for a period, not been collected due to an error with the TSPC e-licensing system. Therefore, the potential revenue loss was understated and the actual revenue loss was less than 11% of total Other Funds (OF) - which is a statistically significant margin of error. The estimated revenue loss to TSPC is \$846,320 OF per biennium.
