My rent in Oregon City is out of control. I rent a two bedroom, two bathroom for myself and son. It is just the two of us. My rent is $\$ 1268$ a month. This is average in the area. I was looking for a new place when my lease renewed in December, but I wasn't able to find a different option. Unless I was willing to live in a place that was deemed "less safe" or give up basic amenities, such as a washer and dryer. Even then, I would only be saving approximately $\$ 100$ a month. My rent was $\$ 945$ when I moved in two years ago. It was raised in December 2015 to $\$ 1045$ and now it is raised to $\$ 1268$. I have no idea what I will do when it gets raised again in December. I can barely afford the rate now. I have friends that own houses and they pay less in mortgage. This current rent is more than half of my monthly wages. I "make too much" for any type of assistance, do not receive child support, so everything is on me. This is an awful situation and I'm hoping you can help.
