Support for HB 2122-A24

Chair Williams and Members of the House Committee on Rules:

The undersigned coordinated care organizations (CCOs) are writing in support of HB 2122, with the -A24 amendments. With these amendments, this bill evolves the coordinated care model toward increased financial transparency and accountability, community engagement, and value-based payment reforms.



Each of these additional accountabilities for CCOs were brought forward by the Oregon Health Policy Board (OHPB) after a robust public process that involved statewide community listening sessions and a broadly distributed survey of Oregonians.



The -A24 amendments bring the language in line with the OHPB recommendations, so we support HB 2122 with the adoption of the -A24 amendments.

The coordinated care model has proven to work by both lowering costs and improving health outcomes for our members. Thank you for the opportunity to continue to advance the coordinated care model.
