I am very concerned about HB2004-A. I have been a landlady in Benton and Deschutes counties since the early 1970's. I have always rented to the first person applying so I was able to give everyone a chance. When there was a problem I never wanted to evict someone for cause because I haven't wanted them to have that on their record. Although there were times I could have given them a 30 day notice I always gave them more time to find a new place to live.

HB2004 will require that I change my policies. First I will have to raise the rents and security deposits to cover the risk of potentially having to give them free rent if I ask them to leave. I will have to be more strict in who I rent to because of the problems HB2004 will create for landlords.

I attend monthly training trying to keep up on all of the new rules and regulations - state, county, city. Most of my renters stay for a decade or more, but we are seriously considering selling our properties because it is getting to be just too difficult and restrictive.
