The Oregon Women's Health and Wellness Alliance (OWHWA), is a group of legislators, health care personnel, state and local agency staff and citizen advocates, who are dedicated to promoting the health, safety and economic well-being of women. Together, the Co-chairs of the OWHWA strongly support HB 3060.

HB 3060 works to reduce discrimination in the workplace. By requiring contractors who wish to work with the state of Oregon to have clear policies and practices that prohibit sexual assault, sexual harassment, and discrimination, the bill will lead to safer work environments. HB 3060 also defines a process by which complaints of discriminatory conduct should be pursued and enforced.
