## To the Honorable Chairman and Members of the Committee to conduct Hearings on the <u>HB2004A</u>

I my strongly opposed to any price fixing, including the discussed rent control measures. They are in conflict with the public interest, because:

- 1) They violate the basic economic law of supply and demand, thus leading to a shortage of the available housing on the market, and to a deterioration of the exising housing accomodations;
- 2) They violate most important economic imperative to respect the people's natural right to own property in this case they deprive the housing owners of their right to control their own property, thus promoting a legalized theft. They are immoral;
- 3) They involve the government and the authors of the rent control measures in the conduct of legitimate landlord's business, that involvement certainly causing taxpayers to pay the bill for it;
- 4) They would serve a very shortsighted interest of a special interest group tenants of rental housing, but at the cost to all other people.

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
