As a physician, I oppose HB 2103 and I urge you to vote NO.

This bill grossly underestimates the importance of training needed to practice medicine and perform safe surgery.

Nurse Practitioners (NPs) are not physicians. More and more, NPs are earning their degrees online with minuscule in-person training in less than two years with no physician oversight ever.

Once credentialed, NPs are governed by a nursing board, again with no medical oversight.

To practice urology, physicians undergo 4 years of post-graduate training and go on to a minimum 5 year urology residency.

This overreach beyond NP scope of practice is ridiculous and dangerous.

For your own family, who would you trust with a scalpel?
