BACKGROUND:

Senate Bill 573 encourages a very specific form of reflection to honor service members who died in war: pausing for 21 seconds at noon on the 21st day of every month. It is based on the patriotic symbolism of the number 21: it being the 21st century; the honor of a 21-gun salute; associating with the Tomb of the Unknowns; and the sum of the numbers "1776."
