The measure moves the Oil-Heated Dwellings Program, known as SHOW at the Department of Energy. The program makes payments to owners of homes that are heated with fuel oil when the owner installs energy conservation items. The Oregon Housing and Community Development Department administers similar weatherization programs that are directed to low income populations to provide housing stability and reduce poverty.

The program is funded through an annual assessment on petroleum suppliers, and OHCS is charged with determining the amount of the assessment with a maximum of \$400,000. All the revenue is generated from these assessments and stay with in this program. There is no anticipation that the assessment process will change but it will be administered elsewhere.
