WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Requires individuals applying for a license to practice respiratory therapy to hold a credential as a Registered Respiratory Therapist. Clarifies respiratory therapy licensing process. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

FISCAL: Minimal fiscal impact. REVENUE: No revenue impact.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

Certified and credentialed respiratory therapists

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

Respiratory care practitioners provide treatment to patients with abnormalities associated with the cardiopulmonary system (i.e., breathing disorders) under the direction of a licensed physician. Respiratory care practitioners administer therapeutic or diagnostic drugs to patients as part of a physician-prescribed treatment plan, implement a physician's orders for respiratory treatments, observe and monitor patient symptoms and assist with administering medical gases (including hyperbaric or standard oxygen, vapor therapies and ventilation support).

House Bill 3104 A clarifies Oregon's licensing process to register as a respiratory therapist.
