RE: OREGON DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY – Request for Catastrophic Wildfire Insurance Policy Premium

Dear Co-Chairs:

Nature of the Request

The Oregon Department of Forestry respectfully requests an appropriation of \$1,689,072 of General Fund and \$1,689,072 of Other Funds authorization to purchase catastrophic wildfire insurance for the 2017 fire season. The insurance policy is identical in structure to last year's policy, providing for \$25 million in large-fire funding coverage in excess of a \$50 million deductible.

Agency Action

The Oregon Department of Forestry has, in coordination since 1973 with the Emergency Fire Cost Committee and the Department of Administrative Services Risk Management Division, acquired a catastrophic wildfire insurance policy, currently through Lloyd's of London. To date, cumulative paid premiums are approximately \$64 million, while pay-outs for large fire costs total about \$102 million, which reflects a positive \$38 million cumulative difference. The policy coverage, premiums and deductibles have all varied throughout the history of this relationship.

This year's total premium cost of \$3,378,144 million represents a reduction of \$148,047 from last year's premium. The Oregon Forestland Protection Fund, as per Oregon Revised Statute 477.775, currently has one-half of the cost of the premium (\$1,689,072) available under the fund's cap to pay for the policy for this year's fire season.

Action Requested

The agency respectfully requests an appropriation of \$1,689,072 from the General Fund and \$1,689,072 of Other Funds authorization to pay the premium for the 2017 fire season's catastrophic wildfire insurance policy.
