PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3113

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 6 through 13 and insert:

"SECTION 2. (1)(a) The Discovery Corps Program is established as a pilot program within the Oregon Youth Conservation Corps. Consistent with the established purposes of the Oregon Youth Conservation Corps, the purpose of the program is to provide opportunities in environmental stewardship and work skills development for disadvantaged and at-risk youth throughout this state through participation in conservation projects on public lands.

6 "(b) The program shall provide employment opportunities for up to 500 9 youth participants, who are 18 to 24 years of age and who have earned a high 10 school diploma or the equivalent of a high school diploma, to work as part 11 of a team to complete conservation projects during a term of service that 12 does not exceed 12 months.".

13 Delete lines 21 through 24 and insert:

"(3) The program director of the Oregon Youth Conservation Corps, in 14 consultation with the Oregon Youth Conservation Corps Advisory Committee 15and the Director of the Office of Community Colleges and Workforce Devel-16 opment, shall issue a request for proposals to select a grant recipient for 17 administering projects under the program that, at a minimum, requires a 18 potential grant recipient to demonstrate the capacity to administer projects 19 for up to 500 youth participants in accordance with the purposes described 20under this section.". 21

1 On page 2, after line 2, insert:

"(5) Not later than September 15, 2018, the program director of the Oregon
Youth Conservation Corps shall submit a report on the status and outcomes
of the program to the Legislative Assembly in the manner provided by ORS
192.245. As part of the report, the program director may make recommendations for legislation.

"SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2017 Act is repealed on January 2,
2020.".
