



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


### **ACA Adults – Spring 2017 Forecast**






### Non-ACA Caseload – Spring 2017 Forecast






#### Parent/Caretaker Relative (PCR) – Spring 2017 Forecast






#### **Children's Medicaid – Spring 2017 Forecast**






#### **CHIP – Spring 2017 Forecast**






### Aid to the Blind and Disabled – Spring 2017 Forecast
