**Work Session Recommendations** 

House Bill 2264 – Relates to fees paid to State Conciliation Service by qualified arbitrators. The measure is effective on the 91st day after adjournment. The House Committee on Business and Labor held a public hearing (2/1) and the work session on the measure (2/8) with a unanimous Do Pass to Ways and Means. A preliminary staff measure summary, fiscal impact, and revenue impact are available on the Oregon Legislative Information System (OLIS). HB 5008, ERB's primary budget measure, includes a policy package with the revenue impact of this measure (\$8,000).
